

Arriving at School



Last week some KS2 pupils were arriving at school before 8.30am (a couple of pupils from 8.05am) and going straight to the KS2 yard.

Any pupils arriving at school before 8.30am without a parent/carer with them MUST go to the school breakfast club in the KS1 hall as no staff supervise the playgrounds before school.

The school breakfast club is open to all pupils from 7.45am every morning and there is no requirement to pre book a place. The sessions are £2.50 a session and can be paid for online using the School Money website.
