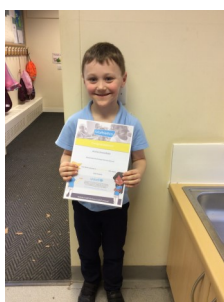
You can only catch the virus if you have been close to a person who has it and the chances of being in contact with the virus is currently low.

Our school has joined the nationwide campaign to help change children's lives, by making story-sharing a habit of a lifetime and creating readers for life.

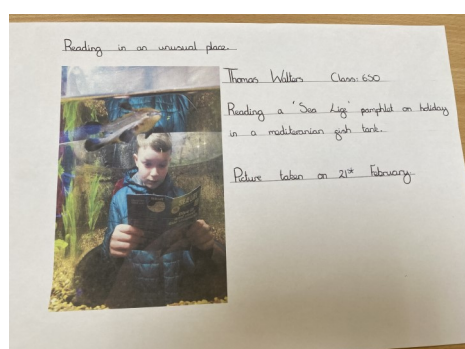
Reading for pleasure is in decline, so we want to boost it back up, raise awareness and spark millions of imaginations.



We will be encouraging our children to help Share A Million Stories and spread the love of books and reading for pleasure, both in school and at home, throughout World Book Day month.

Sharing a story is being read to or reading with an adult, sibling, friend – or pet for a minimum of 10 minutes. Ideally, this takes place at any time throughout the day, from breakfast till bedtime – at the breakfast table, on the bus, in the bath, or in bed.

All children have a sheet to record their reading at home and each class will also be recording their stories shared together in school. All books shared will be added to a national total online each week.
