Coronavirus

The current Government announcement is that we are moving from the contain phase of the coronavirus action plan and into the delay phase, in response to the ongoing coronavirus outbreak.

To support the delay of the spread of the virus, following advice from the Department for Health and Social Care we firmly insist that anyone who shows certain symptoms to stay at home for 7 days, regardless of whether they have travelled to affected areas. This means people should stay at home and avoid all but essential contact with others for 7 days from the point of displaying mild symptoms, to slow the spread of infection.

The symptoms are:

- **A high temperature (37.8 degrees and above)**
- **A new, continuous cough**

The current guidance states that you do not need to call NHS 111 to stay at home. If your symptoms worsen during your stay at home period or are no better after 7 days contact NHS 111 online at 111.nhs.uk. For a medical emergency dial 999.

Again, current advice remains that all schools should remain open and that no education setting should close in response to a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case unless advised to do so by Public Health England.

Therefore, we will continue to educate the pupils in school with an emphasis and importance on personal hygiene and ensuring the pupils are safeguarded to the best of our abilities at all times. All class visits have been cancelled this term and we will let you know about visits planned after Easter as soon as decisions are made.

In the event of an enforced school closure by the government a text message and email will be sent to all parents and carers at the earliest opportunity. In the event of a school closure all class teachers will provide work for the pupils to complete at home via Google Classroom, Mathletics, Bug Club and My Book Blog (KS2). Please inform your child's class teacher, as soon as possible, if you have no internet access at home or if you haven't got the usernames and passwords to access any of the programmes mentioned above.

We will continue to monitor the situation closely and will seek advice from Public Health England as required. We will also contact you if we receive any further advice or guidance.
