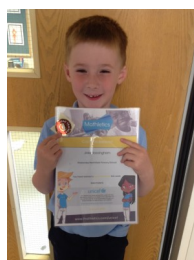


During playtimes and dinnertimes our staff are working hard to ensure the pupils in our school are actively involved in a variety of games and activities.
