In the morning our school gates are open but there are no staff on duty to safeguard pupils outside.


The school's breakfast club is available for children who need to be dropped off before 8:30am. Thankyou for your support and cooperation.

Math Super Powers

We have started a new term so therefore your child will have a new set of Mathematical Super Powers to learn.

These are important for your child as these Super Powers are key mathematical concepts that they will use time and time again.

Please see your child's classroom window and their Google Classroom to check what their super power is.



Term	F1 Key Fact
Autumn 1	Reciting the number names in order 1 - 10.
	Recite numbers past 5.
Autumn 2	Reciting the number names backwards from 10 - 1.
	Fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subilising')
Spring 1	To know the number identifies how many in a set.
	Show 'finger numbers' up to 5.
Spring 2	Counts objects accurately to 5.
	Know that the last number reached when counting a small se of objects tells you how many there are in total ('cardinal principle').
Summer 1	Counting objects accurately to 10.
	Say one number for each item in order: 1.2.3.4.5.
Summer 2	Recognise numerals to 5.
	Link numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral, up to 5.
