Through school children are encouraged to read as much as possible. They are encouraged to read their school book in addition to any text they love to read.

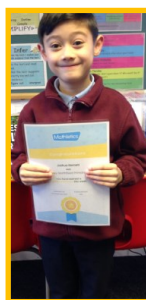
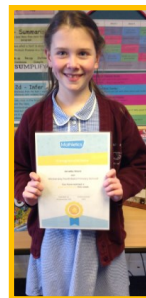
Each class promotes reading in their own way and regularly checks with your child on how they are getting on.



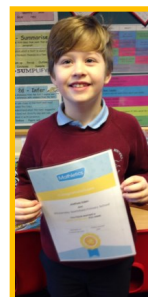
Mathletic Awards

In the morning our school gates are open but there are no staff on duty to safeguard pupils outside.

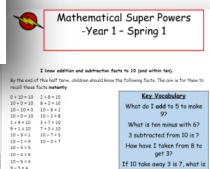
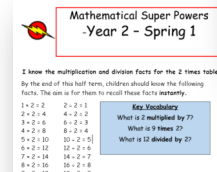
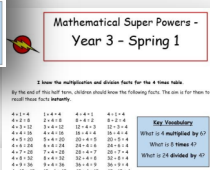
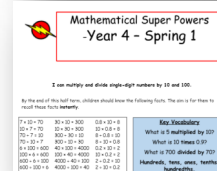
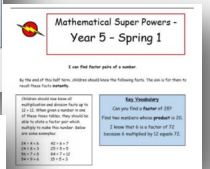
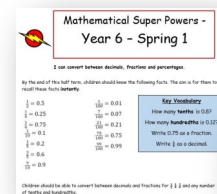
The school's breakfast club is available for children who need to be dropped off before 8:30am. Thankyou for your support and cooperation.

Math Super Powers

We have started a new term so therefore your child will have a new set of Mathematical Super Powers to learn.

These are important for your child as these Super Powers are key mathematical concepts that they will use time and time again.

Please see your child's classroom window and their Google Classroom to check what their super power is.



Term	F2
Autumn 1	To count objects, actions and sounds to 5
Autumn 2	To say the number that is 1 more or less to 10. To say the numbers beyond 10. To subitise to 5
Spring 1	To know the composition of numbers to 10.
Spring 2	To automatically recall number bonds to 5 including subtraction facts
Summer 1	To automatically recall number bonds to 10 including doubles.
Summer 2	To recognise patterns including odd and even

Term	F1 Key Fact
Autumn 1	Recalling the number names in order 1 - 10.
Autumn 2	Recalling the number names backwards from 10 - 1. Fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually (subitising).
Spring 1	To know the number quantities from memory in a set. Three finger number up to 5. Counts objects accurately to 5.
Spring 2	Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total (cardinal principle).
Summer 1	Counting objects accurately to 10. Say one number for each item in order: 1, 2, 3, 4, 5.
Summer 2	Recognise numbers to 5. Link numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral, up to 5.
